**GENERAL RULES FOR YOUTH FEST**

1. All participants must carry their college ID card during the event.
2. Participants must report to the venue 30 minutes before their scheduled time.
3. Registration will be done only after submitting the required documents and photographs and ID card must be provided by the organizer itself.
4. The draw of lots will be conducted in the presence of team in-charges.
5. Time limits for each event must be strictly followed. Exceeding the time limit may lead to marks deduction.
6. Participants must be decently dressed. Costumes should not hurt religious or cultural sentiments and ID cards must be worn at all times within campus.
7. Use of vulgar language, inappropriate gestures, or offensive content is strictly prohibited.
8. Participants must maintain discipline and decorum throughout the event and if anyone found guilty it leads to direct disqualification of entire team from the event.
9. Any damage to college property will result in strict action/ may leads to direct disqualification of entire team from the event.
10. Smoking, alcohol, and any banned substances are strictly prohibited and Participants must respect fellow competitors, organizers, judges, and volunteers.
11. Any special technical requirement must be informed in advance.
12. The organizing college will not be responsible for loss of personal belongings and Participants are advised to take care of their valuables.
13. Any injury during participation will be at the participant's own risk.
14. Certificates will be awarded to all participants. Winners and runners-up will receive prizes as announced. Certificates will not be reissued in case of loss.

15. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
16. No changes in the participant list will be allowed after final submission.
17. Use of hazardous materials (fire, sharp objects, etc.) is not allowed.
18. All teams must cooperate with the organizing committee and volunteers.
19. The organizing committee reserves the right to:
  - a. Make changes to the schedule.
  - b. Cancel or merge events due to insufficient entries.
  - c. Disqualify participants violating rules.
  - d. Use photographs/videos for promotional purposes.
