

Himachal Pradesh Technical University Youth Festival

Rules and Regulations for Cultural Activities

Please read all rules & regulations thoroughly.

1. The participants must bring their ID cards duly signed by the authorities of the Institution affiliated to HPTU.
2. All the participants must bring two photographs for Registration purposes.
3. The time for performance of the proposed events shall be as under:

Group Dance	08-10 minutes
Solo Dance	05-10minutes
Free Style Dance (Theme Based)	05-10minutes
Patriotic Theme Based Group Dance	05-10minutes
Theme Based Skit/Mime	08-10minutes

4. The number of participants in each event shall not be exceeding more than 10. Accompanying person cannot exceed 5 in numbers.
5. The participating teams must bring their required costumes/dresses, the article props along with essential musical instruments.
6. Participating team are suggested to bring their music tracks in 2 pen drives to avoid any sort of late stage hurdles (carrying tracks in mobile phones, laptops are not encouraged). The participating team must submit their music track properly **labelled at the time of registration**.
7. The announcement for the approaching performance will be made from the stage only, and the participating team in charge must be available to listen.
8. The announcement for the team will be made only three times failure to respond will result into disqualification of the team.
9. An Individual can be part of more than one team in this competition. **However, the Organizer shall not be responsible if the team, in which the individual is participating, gets subsequent slot of performance.**

10. Time allots for stage setup, instrument arrangement, sound check, costume setup and overall readiness as applicable **shall not exceed 5 minutes.**
11. All the decisions made by judges will be considered final.(No challenge will be entertained)
12. Any performance that surpasses the designated time limit will lead to team disqualification.
13. Use of fire arms on stage during any event or entire duration of Youth Festival is restrictly prohibited. However in case of unavoidable circumstances the participating institution may take prior permission from the coordinator of the youth festival after giving the justification in writing.
14. There should be no vulgarity and provoke in lyrics, any attempt or provoking the mass will not be tolerated. The participants shall be considered a defaulter and the team will be disqualified.
15. The draw of lots will be conducted in the presence of team in-charges.
16. The judges/organizers hold the right to interrupt or drop the performance any time regardless of the time limit on the basis of unacceptable performance level and or breach of the rules of the event.
